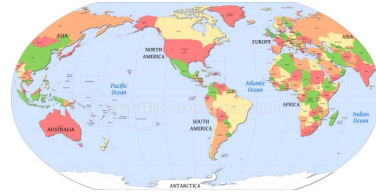


Topics this term
