Playing and Learning

AUTUMN, NOCTURNAL ANIMALS AND LIGHT AND DARK

This term we will be focusing our learning on autumn and the seasonal changes. We will be looking at how the trees and leaves change at this time of year and the wonderful colours we might see. The children will be learning about different seasonal vegetables and how they grow. They will then be making their own yummy vegetable soup!

We will also be learning about different nocturnal animals and where they live. We will be exploring owls, bats and foxes. The children will be reading and sharing a variety of stories and rhymes linked to these animals.

Now that the nights are drawing in we will be talking about the light and dark and how we can be safe. The children will be looking at making shadows and how things look different in a range of light and colours.
