



How we keep your child safe at nursery during Covid-19

Arriving at Nursery School



When you arrive at nursery school there are separate entrances depending on which area of the nursery your child is in. Please wait in these areas with your child, supervising them the whole time. The same applies for any other children you have with you. Only one parent can drop off and pick up their child/children **and parents/carers are required to wear a mask.** Where possible we ask that no other children enter the building.

KEEPING CLEAN



Washing hands-All children will wash their hands on arrival at nursery school. Depending which room your child is in, you may be required to wash your hands too or use hand sanitiser.

All children will be supported to wash their hands throughout the session: before and after eating, coming inside from outdoor play, after coughing and sneezing, after using the toilet, after tactile play activities and before going home.

'Catch it, bin it, kill it'-All staff will teach children the importance of this throughout the day with posters and visual prompts to help children remember.

Please note that children are not permitted to bring any comforters or toys into nursery with them.

The Nursery school is cleaned at certain times of the day to minimise the spread of germs. All resources that children have used will be disinfected daily. Where different children attend in the morning and in the afternoon, separate resources will be used. All areas of the areas of the nursery environment will be well ventilated.



SOCIAL DISTANCING



This is very difficult to achieve with young children; at every opportunity children will be encouraged to play outside and promote social distancing. At eating times and table top activities, staff will limit the amount of children sitting around the tables. Parents are also asked to ensure they social distance when they are in nursery.

HOW WE MANAGE A CONFIRMED CASE OF COVID-19

In line with the nursery school risk assessment for the systems of control please see the separate information leaflet. If there is more than two confirmed cases within a 14 day period or an overall rise in absence due to Covid-19 the school will contact the Health protection team to seek advice. Deep cleaning of effected areas will take place, parents will be notified and kept updated.

TEST & TRACE

The nursery school engages with the NHS Test and Trace guidance. Please see the separate information leaflet regarding this.

ATTENDANCE TO NURSERY SCHOOL

It is the nursery schools policy to monitor all children's attendance. All non-attendance to nursery will be followed up by a telephone call if you have not informed us.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

All staff will wear aprons and gloves when supporting children in the toilet and changing nappies. Staff will only wear full PPE when there is a suspected case of Covid-19.
